



## COPPER LAKES RESIDENT COMMUNICATIONS SAFE SWIMMING DURING COVID-19

A-Beautiful Pools, Inc and your community have worked diligently to adhere to CDC and Local/State Government to open your pools in such a way that mitigates risk for contracting COVID-19. ***\*\*Please note that it is impossible to remove all risk and residents assume risk when attending the community facilities.*** Below is important information for you to prepare for your pool visit as well as being a part of a joint effort to reduce the spread of COVID-19 at the community pool.

Please complete a waiver for all adults and minors in your household that will participate in swimming at the community facility. <https://waiver.smartwaiver.com/v/abpcopperlakes> Please download a copy of this waiver on your mobile device or print. Lifeguards will ask to see your completed waiver each time you attend the pool (only need to complete waiver once and show the same copy each time.)

### **Pool Policies for Residents**

1. Please do not enter the pool area if you or anyone in close contact with you have had symptoms of illness (fever cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell) in the past 72 hours. You should stay home until CDC's posted isolation criteria are met.
2. Waiver will need to be completed prior to visit. Gate guard will have a copy of the waiver to complete electronically if needed.
3. Please sign in when you arrive at the pool. Be prepared with ID and pool tags/cards. This sign in process is important for many reasons and will be how we contact trace in the instance of a positive case at the community pool.
4. All patrons should wear a face covering when not in the water.
5. Always maintain 6 feet of social distancing with members not in your household. This should be maintained in the water, waiting for use of an amenity, in the restrooms, upon entrance and exit and when speaking with the lifeguards.
6. Please review and follow all posted signage at the facility when you visit.
7. Please use the hand sanitizer to clean your hands when you arrive and as you leave the facility.
8. Restroom usage will be limited to one household at a time. Signs will be posted.
9. Furniture will be provided at the pool and it is the responsibility of the user to sanitize each piece you use before and after use with the wipes provided at the pool.

*\*\*This information in this release is not binding and can be adjusted at any time due to future releases of information from Local, State or National Government.*

**Resident Access-** A-Beautiful Pools, Inc. will have a lifeguard at the front gate to check in residents, inform them of COVID-19 policies, check waiver is completed and confirm they have not had any COVID-19 symptoms in the last 72 hours.

**Disinfecting-** ABP lifeguards will disinfect gate entry, check in area and restrooms hourly. ABP will clean and disinfect stands, handrails, surfaces, restrooms, pump rooms, guard rooms, all doors, etc. each evening.
